



This project was commissioned by two NPOs which organize Arts and Theater events in a closed school building. They wished to have a common space where various visitors, actors, artists, and adults and children from the neighbors, communicate with each other. For saving the limited budget, we tried not to purchase new material but re-use the stuffs such as hands of people and leaves of trees existing there. We had workshops and made leaf-stamps on the wall, and for many times and by many people, thousands of wishes have been marked into the space. People love this place and call it "Room of Happiness". Many of the neighbors drop by and relax here, including those who had never entered the building in the past.
