She has been working on several spatial design projects in the field of children's education, play environment, museums and International cooperation project, focusing on how to improve people's imagination, creativity and ownership to empower them to make their happy living condition by themselves.

On 2015, she was awarded "Innovative Architects for the Future Prize" from the Tokyo Society of Architecture and Building Engineers for "Maternity House Project in Zambia", in which she succeeded to help reducing the number of maternal mortality in rural areas in Zambia, by using her unique participatory design approach in the process of planning and finishing health facilities.
